Jones Cemetery—Section 17—Kinmundy Township—on Simmons Road south of Press.
(just north of home of Larry and Judy McCarty)

- First buried in 1863—Francis Jones—Civil War soldier—died of pneumonia in a camp in Paducah, Kentucky area—20 years old.
- His parents—Jackson (born 1/17/1818) and Seletha Whiteside Jones (born 7/22/1822)
- Children of Jackson and Seletha (also called Margaret)
 - Francis
 - Talaha Wright
 - James R (Ras) wife Mahala Foster Jones
 - Sarah Jones Lowe (1st wife of Charlie Lowe)
 - Ann Jones Lowe (2nd wife of Charlie Lowe)
 - Sam (wife Hannah Atkins)
- Infants of several of the couples and grandchildren of Jackson and Margaret died before they were 20 from appendicitis and other causes.
- Last burial—Sam Jones (Son of Jackson and Margaret) 1939
- Rosalyn Lowe Uphold is a great granddaughter of Ann Jones Lowe (Ann—Willie Lowe—Charles Lowe)
- I am a great grandson of Ras Jones (Ras—G. Frank—James Robb—Jim Jones)
- Same Lowe (as in Sam and Jane) is a grandson of Ann Jones Lowe (Ann Jones Lowe—Sam Sr.—Sam Jr.)
- The only grandchildren of Jackson and Margaret buried in the cemetery are some who died as infants.
- I live on the house spot where Jackson and Margaret and later Ras and Mahala and my parents—James Robb Jones and Nelda Gray Jones lived.
