This cemetery is located in Section 31 of Meacham twp., and just east of Albany Road, thru a 40 acre field, and into a wooded area.

The coordinates are N 38 degrees 44' 37.4208" and W 88 degrees 47' 21.2388".

We're not sure of the exact name of this cemetery. It was once owned by James "Buck" Sculley, who had married Margaret C. Potter in 1881 in Marion Co., IL. Margaret was the daughter of Thomas Potter and Louisa Jane (Smith) Potter. Prior to Sculley owning it for a few years before moving to the St. Louis, MO area, it was owned for many years by Thomas Potter, a long time Meacham twp. Resident, and the father of Margaret C. (Potter) Sculley.

In 1892, the tract of land was owned by Thomas Potter III, in 1915, by B. Sculley, and around 1950, by William Schneider.

In the 1900 census, James "Buck" Sculley and Margaret (Potter) Sculley were living in St. Louis, MO. In 1910, they were living in Meacham twp. In the Post Dispatch newspaper in St. Louis, the obituary was printed for James "Buck" Sculley who died on Nov. 16, 1919.
