To secure uniformity in the mode of keeping these records, at the request of a number of members, the Board of Publication have prepared this book.

### SPECIMEN RECORDS.

We present the following, as a proper method of recording the Minutes of the Session:

### MINUTES OF SESSION.

1869.

Nov. 1st.

NASHVILLE, TENNESSEE.

The Session met—7 o'clock P. M. Present...John D——, Moderator, with Elders A—— B—— and C——. The meeting was opened with prayer. The minutes of the last meeting were read.

E——, F—— and R—— having given satisfactory evidence of their conversion to God by His Holy Spirit, were admitted to full membership in this Church.

It appearing that common fame charges James D —— with unchristian conduct in several particulars, the Moderator and Elder A—— were appointed a committee to confer with him, and report to the Session at its next meeting.

Robert S—— appeared before the Session and preferred certain charges against Charles P——. After hearing the charges, the Session directed its Clerk to give the accused a copy of the same, with the names of the witnesses supporting them, and to cite all concerned to appear at the next meeting of the Session.

Elders B—— and C —— were appointed to visit Mrs. W—— and family, and afford such relief as may be needed.

Elder B—— was appointed to attend the next meeting of Presbytery, and Elder C—— his alternate.

On motion of Elder A——, Session adjourned. Prayer by——.

## MINUTES OF SESSION.

Records of Good Hope society of <sup>the</sup> Cumberland  
Presbyterian Church in the bounds and under the  
care of the McLinn Presbytery, Good Hope society of the C. P.  
church was organized by Rev W<sup>m</sup> Finley Nov 9<sup>th</sup> 1844  
at the house of Mr Jacob Carl in Lovells Prairie.

A session was formed consisting of Isaac Eagan, and  
James C. Lackey, Ruling Elders of Mt. Carmel Society  
of the C. P. Church, Rev W<sup>m</sup> Finley, Jacob Carl,  
Thomas, K. Hadden, Elizabeth A. White, and Sarah Ann White  
having expressed their desire to be connected with the  
Society about to be organized, were released from the  
care of Mt. Carmel Society, and recommended to Good  
Hope Society, Alexander Millican and Jane Howard  
gave satisfactory evidence of their having been  
members of the Presbyterian Church, and of their piety  
and were received as members, W<sup>m</sup> Howard gave a  
relation of his experience of Grace which was satisfactory  
and he was received, Eliza L. Morris, and Martha A. Hadden  
stood propounded for membership, An Election was then  
held upon which Jacob Carl, Thomas Hadden, and Alex  
ander Millican were elected to the office of Ruling Elders  
in Good Hope Society, after a few remarks from the  
Moderator (Mr Finley) respecting the ordination of Elders  
arrangement was made to attend to the ordination  
of the persons elected, the same evening in the presence  
of the congregation the persons elected were duly ordain  
ed to said office of Ruling Elders in Good Hope Society.

## MINUTES OF SESSION.

Omega Illinois March 7<sup>th</sup> 1845.

The session of Good Hope society met, present Rev W<sup>m</sup> Finley, Elders Jacob Carl and Alexander Millican.

The meeting was opened with prayer, Eliza L. Hadden Martha A. Hadden and Clementine A. Millican, having given satisfactory evidence of their conversion to God by his holy Spirit were admitted to full membership in this Church.

March 14<sup>th</sup> 1847. Mr James Coleman and his wife Sarah, presented their letters of dismission and recommendation from Leipers Fork Society in Williamson County Tenn, to Good Hope Society and were admitted to full membership in this Church, Miss A. Beard having given satisfactory evidence of her conversion to God by his holy Spirit was also admitted to full membership,

present John Walls Minister, Jacob Carl Thomas Hadden and Alex Millican Elders,

May 9<sup>th</sup> 1847. Mr A. G. Denton, and Francis his wife presented their letters of dismission and recommendation from Leipers Fork Society in Nashville Presbytery, Williamson County Tenn, to Good Hope Society and were admitted to full membership in this church.

Sep 10<sup>th</sup> 1848, the session met, present Rev W<sup>m</sup> Finley Elders Jacob Carl, Thomas Hadden, and A. Millican, Margaret Hadden and Wester Ann Howard having given satisfactory evidence of their conversion to God by his holy Spirit were admitted to full membership in this church.

March 24 1849, Mr Samuel Higgason and Elizabeth his wife presented their letters of recommendation & dismission from Salem Church of the C. P. Church and were admitted to full membership in this Church, March 24 1849
